

Dear St. Mary Parishioners,

We have teamed up with the administration at All Saints Academy to address the awareness of the expansion that is needed for our Catholic grade school. The projected goal is to raise \$2.8 million to fund an addition to the west side of the elementary building and to remodel existing space for more efficient utilization. Currently, \$1.7 million has been raised.

Due to the tremendous growth in enrollment at ASA, a 20% increase since the 2017/2018 school year, more room is needed to maintain their commitment to an effective student-to-teacher ratio (16.5:1) and to continue to provide a faith-based education to the children of our community. This addition would allow for 5 classrooms, an outdoor learning area, faculty conference room and staff office space.

The current office space is in the basement of one of the buildings, which is a safety concern. The new office location would ensure better visibility of campus for the administration and office staff and increase accessibility.

We are asking the community for their support to help fund this expansion. There are multiple options on how you can give. 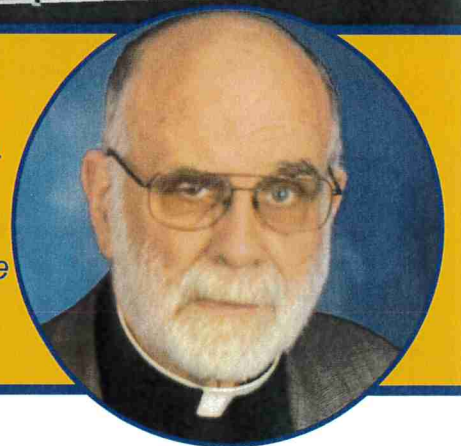

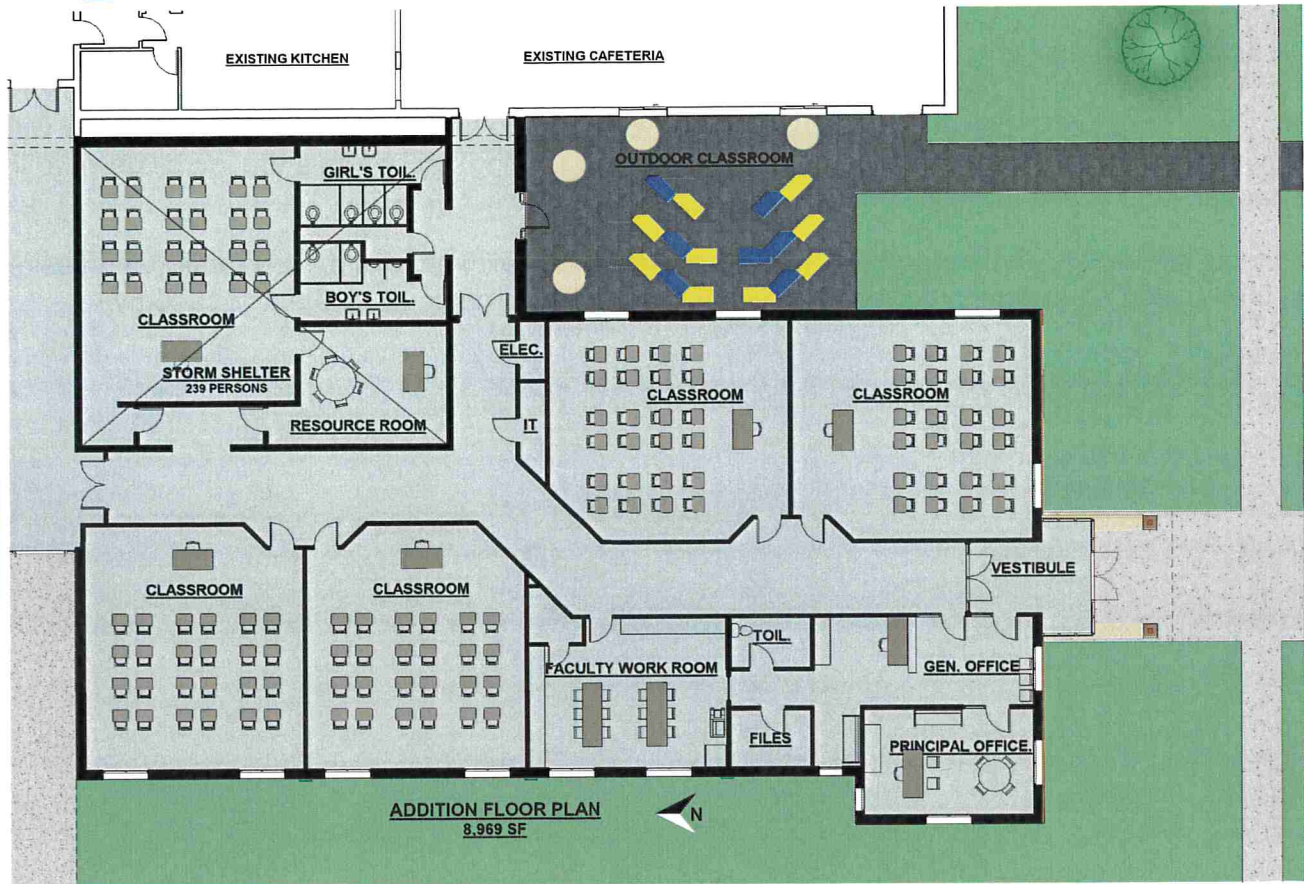
